



CITY OF CARTERSVILLE - UPDATES REGARDING THE CORONAVIRUS 3/20/2020:

The City of Cartersville has been closely following and monitoring the Coronavirus situation, both locally and nationally. As new concerns and challenges have presented themselves, the City has been addressing them and revising procedures as needed. At this time, the City is striving to increase social distancing where possible, throughout the community and in City offices. Each City department has been creating a contingency plan for the services they provide.

Beginning on Monday, March 23rd the following changes will be implemented:

- City staff will be working on rotating shifts
- Yard waste and recycling service will be suspended
- Bulk leaf pick-up will be picked up at a later date
- Customer Service drive-through will be open Monday through Friday from 8 AM until noon, and from 1 PM until 5 PM, however, it will be closed from noon to 1 PM each day.

Please note, there will be no utility service disruption related to the COVID19. However, please be aware there may be a response delay in service calls.
