PACK EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

Stock your vehicle with a mobile phone, charger, batteries, blankets, flashlight, first-aid kit, high-calorie non-perishable food, candle to melt snow for drinking water, sack of sand or cat litter for traction, shovel, scraper, and battery booster cables.



GET THE WEATHER FORECAST

Change your travel plans if hazardous weather is expected.



Call 511 or visit GDOT's webpage to check on road conditions. Choose a different route or adjust your travel plans if road conditions are poor.



READY YOUR VEHICLE

Check your battery, wipers, coolant and other systems affected by cold temperatures. Make sure your tires have good tread. Clear snow and ice from your windows, lights, and side mirrors.
