(Based upon the list issued by the Office of the Attorney General, Georgia on August 1, 2011)

Drivers License (Drivers License & ID Cards from all states in the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, The Northern Marianas Islands, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, or the Swain Islands as long as the card has a photograph and identifying information.)
